Power station – time for a plan

ACT Greens MLA Deb Foskey has said it is time for a plan to deal with concerns regarding the proposed power station data centre.

“ActewAGL is holding a community consultation at the Vikings Club tomorrow.”

That meeting will be neither constructive nor pleasant if residents are still of the belief that the proposal will be pushed through on Mugga Land, whatever its impact and whatever their concerns” Dr Foskey said today.

“It is time for the ACT Government to come out with a respectful process to explore all the options in an open and transparent way, something that is much broader than the Preliminary Assessment of the ActewAGL proposal that is presently with ACT Planning and Land Agency.”

“I think however we need a more open process which looks at all the possibilities, rather than simply giving a yes or a no to the current proposal.”

“In the lead up to an election we risk this proposal becoming an all or nothing battle which would simply guarantee a poor outcome” Dr Foskey said.
